- In addition to developing a tutorial website relating to Meridian's in-house software, I wrote an extensively researched report about email marketing – given my academic background prior to university, I have strong skills in research and report writing.

Key projects:

- **MeetVR:** I began work toward this Node.js app for Google Cardboard during my placement year, and will complete a prototype for my final-year project.
- **Department website:** I was one of the main front-end developers of the central site of an Accenture UK department, working with Jade, Sass and Angular.js. In addition, I added features to the site's custom-built CMS, which utilises MongoDB.
- **Prototype:** In the last months of my Accenture placement, I was the sole front-end developer on an innovative Node.js prototype app.

- **Societies:** I was the secretary of Teesside's LGBT society and have been involved with several other societies at both Teesside and Northumbria.
